## COMPETE WITH AND AGAINST THE BEST

Our teams compete against the top players and teams at competitions such as Provincial Zone Team Championships, Western Canada Games, NCAA sanctioned tournaments in the U.S. and the National Canadian Midget and Juvenile Championships.

## DID YOU KNOW

Basketball BC Provincial Team members earn External High School Credits and are eligible for the Child Tax Credit.

Athlete's participation fees cover less than 50% of the overall program expenses. Basketball BC absorbs the rest.

Every Basketball BC Provincial Team medaled at the Canadian National Championships last summer.

The 2011 Basketball BC Provincial Team Head Coaches have competed in a combined 39 National Championships and have won 17 Gold Medals as players and coaches.

Participation in Basketball BC's programs provides athletes with exposure to CCAA, CIS, NCAA and Canadian National Team Coaches.
